Problem Statement:	"Cycle Rickshaw" is a very common and cheapest mode of transport for short distance travel in the India. Rickshaw serves as modest upward mobility for the people who come from village to city just for a simple cause, feed the bellies of their family members even once a day. The activity of rickshaw pullers depicts an unsustainable livelihood. The intergenerational mobility of the family members of rickshaw pullers is confined to very little schooling and bleak range of job opportunities. Also, they are very much susceptible to the series of health issues. Downgrading health conditions added upon with health shocks and negligence due to lucre issues degrade their pace of upward mobility. A big segment of these rickshaw pullers are migrated from rural areas of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar. A city like Lucknow has 9,000 pullers, of whom 90 per cent do not own the cycle rickshaws. Objectives, expected results and main activities	This project aims to pull the families of rickshaw-pullers out of the vicious circle of poverty towards sustainable livelihoods. Key Activities: Providing interest-free loans for buying e-rickshaws with long-term repayment plan. Improving design of e-rickshaws and using them for local advertisements. Forming Co-operative societies of rickshaw-pullers in each city for better bargaining and availing benefits of government schemes. Registration in all the relevant schemes as well as proper identification cards and bank accounts for all family members. Enrollment of small children in elementary schools/IPES.	
Project Summary:	 Majority of the rickshaw-pullers work for an average of more than 10 hours a day to earn a better livelihood. Average earning of a rickshaw puller per day is around Rs.300 – Rs.450. Around 6-8% of rickshaw-pullers own their cycle rickshaws. Rest, pay a rent of around Rs.50- Rs.100 per day for a rickshaw. Majority of the rickshaw-pullers are Hindus. However, Muslims are a close second with high absolute numbers. Majority of the rickshaw-pullers are illiterate. Those who were literate, most of them received only primary or higher primary level of education or were dropouts due to financial problems. Most of them spend their nights by sleeping on their rickshaw or footpaths or railways platforms or Jhuggies/slums or rain baseras. Such places lack proper toilets, water supply, etc. A miniscule percentage are able to afford rented houses.
