Problem Statement:	<p>In India only 18.8% take up higher education. Further, only 11 out of 100 Muslims in India take up higher education – the lowest as regards religion-based enrolment in higher education. In comparison, 20% Hindus and 31% Christians pursue higher education. The situation is worse in rural India – only 6.7% Muslims take up higher education.</p> <p>Sachar Committee report points out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Less than 4% of Muslims are graduates or diploma holders compared to about 7% of the population aged 20 years and above. • Only 1 out of 25 students enrolled for an undergraduate program. • Only 1 out of 50 students enrolled for a postgraduate program is a Muslim. 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The percentage of Muslim men enrolling for a degree course is lower than that of women. <p>Percentage of SC/STs in premier institutions of higher learning like IIT, IIMs and AIIMS has shown an upward trend due to reservation policy. However, Muslims fare badly in reaching there. <p>Project Summary:</p> <p>Objectives, expected results and main activities</p>	<p>The concept</p> <p>There is a need to create intelligentsia which is unbiased, competitive and socially committed. In this endeavor we need to nurture the best minds from the community who can compete with the best of the world. Many bright Muslim students are unable to get into premier institutions of higher learning due to lack of proper and affordable guidance. The aim of this initiative is to fill this gap by creating a model coaching center for IIT and Pre-Medical Entrance Exams*.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> To identify academically bright students from whole of north India in the first phase and whole of India in second phase. To impart high quality guidance to bright students at affordable fees. To provide merit-cum-means scholarships to deserving students upto 100%. To create a residential coaching model with 24 x7 support for students (Phase II). To develop the overall personality of the students with the aim of making leaders of tomorrow. <p><i>*In the first year batch for MBBS Entrance shall be started. Later, batches for IIT-JEE shall be added.</i></p>
No. of Beneficiaries:	Direct beneficiaries- 60 meritorious students (2 batches) in first year
Target:	3 coaching centers in 2 years, each with a capacity of 240 students
